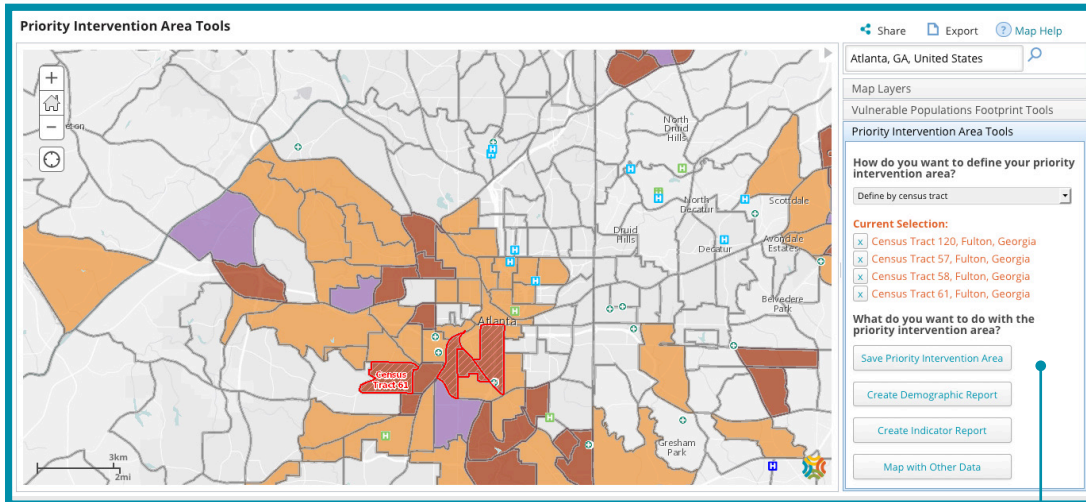




# Priority Intervention Area Tools

1. From the home page, click on **Maps & Data** then select [Vulnerable Populations Footprint](#)
2. Enter your location and click on **Priority Intervention Area Tools**



3. Select your geography and click the area on the map you would like to identify. Your Priority Intervention Area will show on the map in red hash marks. You can click the 'X' next to any selected area to remove it from the map.

4. Click **Save Priority Intervention Area** to save the area you have created. Name and describe the Priority Intervention Area and then choose the sharing setting.

5. Click **Create Demographic Report** to create a brief demographic report of your Priority Intervention Area. Choose the file format for your report and the report will generate and can then be downloaded.

6. Click **Create Indicator Report** to generate a CHNA report for your Priority Intervention Area.

7. Click **Map with Other Data** to generate a map with the selected Priority Intervention Area that you can add your own selected data to.
