1. From the top navigation bar, click **Maps & Data** then select: [Build a Report](#)

2. Select the report area. Start by choosing a state and then a county. You can include multiple counties in one report.

3. Next, click **View Report** and explore the six data categories.

**Total Population**

A total of 619,297 people live in the 152.94 square mile report area defined for this assessment according to the U.S. Census Bureau American Community Survey 2009-13 5-year estimates. The population density for this area, estimated at 4,049.38 persons per square mile, is greater than the national average population density of 88.23 persons per square mile.
