



How to Make a Map

1. From the homepage top bar, click on **Maps & Data** then select [Make a Map](#).
2. Add data to your map by typing in a keyword or explore your options by choosing either [Browse data by topic](#) | [Browse data by source](#).

3. Explore data options by clicking on the arrows next to indicator categories.
4. Search by Keyword using the Search Data box.
5. Check the indicators you would like to map, then click [Add to Map](#).

6. Zoom to your community by entering a location in the search bar or by using the plus or minus buttons on the map.
7. In the map legend on the right, turn off selected layers by clicking the check box. Check the box again to turn the layer back on. Delete layers by clicking the [Remove](#) button.
